

Feature cards


The features will now be displayed on "feature cards," as opposed to a table format, in order to optimize space and make information easier to view

Feature cards

Feature cards are easier to collapse if you want to explore just looking at the status, title, and preview and GA dates

Status is now represented visually on the feature card to save space and make it more glanceable




You can now sort the feature cards by either preview date or GA date and by oldest or newest
