
Here we explore how cross-agency collaboration can help governments detect fraud, waste, abuse, and corruption while addressing the challenges—and how to overcome them.

#### Get a 360-degree view


Governments need a complete view of their communities so they can better serve them and protect against any misconduct. Data collection is a big part of this view, and possible only when different agencies cooperate and share information.

#### **Deploy data analysis**

Having more data can be exciting, but reliable analysis is often hard to come by.

To make sense of your data, meaningful analysis needs to come from government workers who understand how the data is connected—how the different parts work together to create a complete picture.


